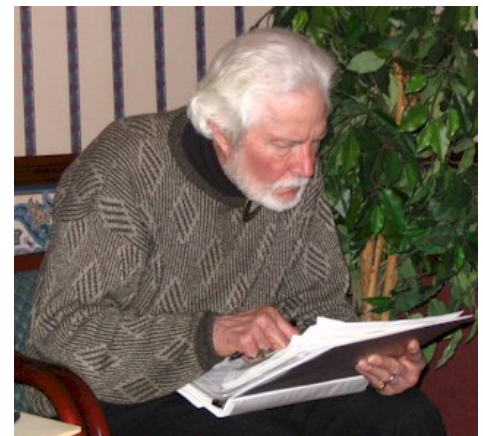
Program
